2nd Annual Lake Greenwood Open TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- * Deadline for entry is at the Greenwood State Park on the morning of the tournament.
- * Launch sequence will be determined by when entry fee is received.
- * All live-wells will be checked prior to tournament.
- * Scoring
 - 5 bass limit (large mouth only). Any team bringing more than 5 fish to scales will lose biggest fish until down to 5 fish limit.
 - Minimum length will be 12 inches. Length will be determined by Golden Rule.
 - Short fish brought to scale will result in 1 pound penalty. More than one short fish brought to scales will result in disqualification.
 - For each dead fish brought to scale, there will be a .25 (1/4) pound penalty.
 - Late penalty is 1 pound per minute up to 15 minutes. Disqualification after 15 minutes.
- * All live fish will be released.
- * Only artificial baits can be used. All bass must be caught alive in a legal and sporting manner. No trolling...No snagging.
- * Anchor Rule: A team boat sitting with trolling motor up and anchor out, all other team boats in this tournament must stay 50 yards away.
- * All teams and their boats are to remain in the water at all times during tournament hours except for Emergencies.
- * In case of breakdown, one team member may bring fish to weigh-in in another team's boat.
- * Alcoholic beverages will not be allowed during tournament hours.
- * Good sportsmanship is expected from all teams. Disorderly conduct may result in disqualification.
- * All complaints or protests should be made to the director within 15 minutes after conclusion of weigh-in.
- * All decisions by the tournament officials will be final.
- * All teams are to abide by State Rules and Regulations.
- * Any team is subject to polygraph test. Refusal or failure to do so will result in disqualification and forfeit of winnings.
